A Grade Girls.

Firstly, I would like to say a big thank you to Alex Novak for joining up to the A Grade Girls Division. It's encouraging to see the girls division going from strength to strength.

Heat 1 and heat 2 really saw the girls stepping up and committing to the conditions at Parsons. It was encouraging to see the girls actively going for waves and negotiating challenging conditions in the comp. In heats 1 and 2, all of the girls had some great take offs and rides. Madi and Bella were unlucky to make it through after a terrific effort from both of the girls.

In the final, Yasmin took out the win with some convincing waves, in particular, a terrific high scoring wave that she rode almost back to the beach with two changes in direction.

Imi was more than stepping up to the mark in A Grade and took out second place after performing an awesome roundhouse cutback. After some amazing surfing all day, Kirra took out third position and Alex took out fourth.

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C Grade Comp 5 report

Microgroms C-Grade: Competition 5
Sponsored by

Date: 28th June 2016

Surf Location: Middleton, Chapman Road, toilet block

Weather conditions: sunny, 10 degrees, wind 0-5 knots offshore

Swell size: waist to shoulder height (grom)

Number of competitors: 11

The surf conditions out the back were clean and glassy, around 2 foot plus. Unfortunately, the shore break proved a bit tricky for the groms to get past. Consequently, they surfed the white water on the inside. The heats in round one consisted of six groms in the first heat and five groms in the second heat. The same format was used in round two. All the groms surfed two heats each so the comp zone was pretty busy with

The judges did a great job of keeping up with the riders. Apologies to any of the judges who have found an extra grey hair or two in the morning.

The comp started well and I thought Ashton had an outstanding comp. He later confirmed it by telling how well he had done. We love confident surfers in the C Grade:). Madison is another surfer who is growing in confidence hence Peter, our head judge, selected her for the comp director's award for tenacity and perseverance.

The two outstanding surfers of the day were Tommy and King. Tommy snatched a green water take off and managed to max out the wave's scoring potential. The three judges were so impressed with Tommy's controlled turns they scored him 9's and an 8.5. King showed he too is a class act with his best wave scoring 8 across the judging panel. Tommy, however, was the grom of the moment taking out comp five with the highest combined score over the two rounds.

Please remember that the Club does not run Competitions based on age. They are run on individual ability and confidence. As such, Members can compete in <u>any</u> division they choose to and whilst members have the opportunity to participate in any Club Competition, no one is compelled to surf if they feel that the conditions are unsuitable.

Please make sure that your child is financial before they compete in their second comp.

A reminder to all parents or guardians, it is your responsibility for your child's safety and you must attend all contests that their child enters. If you cannot attend a particular event, at which you allow your child to compete, you must organise transport and supervision for your children and do so at your own risk.

If you are not going to be there on time, please let a committee member know so you can get your name put down on the Entry List. It is each member's responsibility to put their name down by 8:15am so that the Contest Director can have the heats drawn ASAP. If your name is not down, you may not be able to surf. Parents of young children, please help them with this process.

All members & parents are reminded not to surf in the contest area as points may be deducted at the next Comp. Competitors please leave the competition zone after their heat has finished.

Parents are asked to help with judging when their children are not involved. When your child is competing parents are reminded to stand 10m away from the judging area as we encourage all heats to be judged fairly & without any influence.
