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Important information

Microgroms became aware of a proposed Tuna pen being constructed off the coastline of Victor Harbour.

Reuben your Microgroms president has been working tirelessly to oppose this, doing interviews with the press and attending meetings. Along with the newsletter, there is a form attached. To lodge your opposition to the tuna pen, you can print off, complete and send. If we sign a club petition, it would only count as one vote. We all need to lodge individual representations against the proposed tuna pen development.

I/We oppose the Aquarium on the basis that it will cause

- 1. Loss of visual amenity in beautiful Victor Harbour.
- 2. Increased shark activity and potential increase of accidents with people.
- 3. Disagree Marine park should be used as "resource" when it is actually the environment for all to use, not just a select privileged few that can afford it.
- 4. Predation to fairy penguin by increased shark activity.
- 5. Leafy Sea Dragon habitat threatened.

If the people friendly waters are no longer safe, you will be likely to visit Victor Harbour less, and hence spend less money in and around the town ship and neighbouring towns.

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A Grade Comp report 10

What a fantastic finish to the 2015 Microgroms competition season, with beautiful warm weather, clear skies and 2 to 3 foot swell running. Our 'meet and greet' at Middleton for a club photo was so good we decided to hold the comp for all divisions together at Day street. It was a great sight to see all the divisions sharing the beach together, and consuming the benefits (thanks 'B' grade for the sausage and drinks option!)

Although it seemed there were surfers for as far as the eye could see, the crowds had very little impact on the competitors, as they all seemed to get plenty of waves. After a quick warm up surf, we called the groms in and kicked off the first of the heats for the A1 and A2 divisions.

The A1s had 7 competitors hit the water, and there was some great surfing through the heats, requalies and the final. Congratulations to all the finalists who surfed really well throughout the day. Harri Green who in the semi's made one of the best turns of the year, caught on camera in a 2 part sequence (check it out on facebook), also did a very nice closeout manoeuvre on a smaller one in the final showing off his radical style to take 4th. Khi was also hunting lots of waves, and in the middle of the final caught a great wave, but couldn't get onto another one to back it up, resulting in 3rd place. 2ndplace went to Caspian, who in the final made one of best waves of the day, on one of the biggest waves ridden, with smooth linked up turns and a massive snap in a critical section. He was rewarded with the highest wave score of the day, unfortunately for Caspian he too was unable to back it up too and didn't get another high scoring wave. The win was snapped up by Levi, who picked his waves well, his selection of longer peeling waves allowed him to throw a variety of smooth linked up turns, resulting in consistent good scores, well done Levi!

Please remember that the Club does not run Competitions based on age. They are run on individual ability and confidence. As such, Members can compete in <u>any</u> division they choose to and whilst members have the opportunity to participate in any Club Competition, no one is compelled to surf if they feel that the conditions are unsuitable.

Please make sure that your child is financial before they compete in their second comp.

A reminder to all parents or guardians, it is your responsibility for your child's safety and you must attend all contests that their child enters. If you cannot attend a particular event, at which you allow your child to compete, you must organise transport and supervision for your children and do so at your own risk.

If you are not going to be there on time, please let a committee member know so you can get your name put down on the Entry List. It is each member's responsibility to put their name down by 8:15am so that the Contest Director can have the heats drawn ASAP. If your name is not down, you may not be able to surf. Parents of young children, please help them with this process.

All members & parents are reminded not to surf in the contest area as points may be deducted at the next Comp. Competitors please leave the competition zone after their heat has finished.

Parents are asked to help with judging when their children are not involved. When your child is competing parents are reminded to stand 10m away from the judging area as we encourage all heats to be judged fairly & without any influence.
